There are four different ESOL course levels:

pre-intermediate • intermediate upper-intermediate • advanced

All of our courses explore language through everyday topics of family, daily routine, accommodation, society and culture, and grammar.

ESOL learners in the community are also very much welcome at the college. Our staff often visit community ESOL classes and organise college ESOL events that community ESOL students can join.
