You think that being on your feet all day is much better than sitting on an office chair





There are also a few more skills you need to have to thrive in this career...

We searched tons of job adverts and here are the top five transferable skills we see mentioned for people working in this industry.

Don't worry if you don't already have these skills. We work on gaining or improving transferable skills* in college.



1. Interpersonal

Simply meaning that you are a sociable person. Whether you are a Nail Tech, Make-up Artist, Hairdresser or Beauty Therapist, you are going to spend a good part of your day talking with and listening to people. If you love to talk or listen, then this is a good career for you.

2. Communication

Being a good communicator is all about being able to communicate exactly what procedure you will be carrying out and what your client can expect. Being able to listen, understand and interpret is key in this industry.

3. Learning

Trends, products and equipment change regularly and so you need to keep your skills up to date. In this industry, you need to have a desire to always be improving and developing your skills.

4. Time Keeping

You will be juggling lots of appointments each day and so your timekeeping is super important. No one likes to be left waiting and so you need to manage your time to keep your clients happy.

5. Team Player

While you will spend lots of time one-on-one with clients you will also typically be working alongside others. You might be renting a chair/room in a salon or be employed but you will spend your day surrounded by others.

*Transferable skills – skills that can be applied to lots of jobs. These are skills you learn at school, college or jobs you have done in the past.


